STATE OF WISCONSIN, MARATHON COUNTY TOWN OF KNOWLTON ORDINANCE #2012-10-22

The Town Board of the Town of Knowlton, Marathon County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30(1), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of election officials, as deemed necessary by the Town Clerk, to work at different times on each election day as follows:

There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
